**Australian War Memorial Travelling Exhibition - Gallipoli: a Turkish view 8 October - 29 November 2009**

Camden Library will be hosting Gallipoli: a Turkish view from AWM throughout October and November. The exhibition aims to convey insights into the Turkish experience and remembrance of the Gallipoli campaign. The exhibition covers four main themes: the Turkish naval victory 1915, the Turkish defenders of Gallipoli, the Gallipoli/Canakkale campaign and the aftermath of the campaign. These themes are interpreted through black and white framed photographs and contemporary colour photographs drawn from the Memorial's collection, plus a selection of Turkish relics displayed in two showcases.

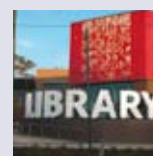
